

2024 SDUST Summer Camp for Chinese Language and Culture Learning

PERIOD: 3 Weeks (June 24–July 14, 2024)

REQUIREMENT: official KuzSTU student, Chinese level (basic and above)

COURSES: Conversational Chinese; Chinese Cultural Practice; Cultural Tour

FEES:

1. Free application and tuition fees; Free airport pick-up/drop-off for group arrival/departure only; Free cultural tour transportation (within the city and only once)
2. On-campus accommodation fees: 1050 CNY (with basic facilities & beddings—BIAB: a pillow + case, a sheet, a pad, a duvet + cover)
3. Insurance fees: 160 CNY
4. Food, possible tickets in cultural visit and other personal expenditure are self-paid.

NUMBER OF APPLICANTS: 5

APPLICATION (3 steps):

1. Nomination deadline: **May 5**. (fill in Attachment 1-*Nomination Form*)
2. Online application deadline (**SDUST International Student Service System** <https://sdust.at0086.cn/student>): **May 12**. (see Attachment 2-*Guide for Online Application*.)
3. Insurance purchase: **between May 12 and May 20** before entry (see Note #2 for details)

IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. Documents for online application include but not limited to: **Passport, Profile photo** (in JPG, PNG or other image form), **college transcripts** of all previous semesters, current college *Studying Certificate* (Attachment 3). Any documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be provided with the Chinese or English translation.
2. All participants must buy the Comprehensive Medical Insurance for international students in China. The minimum package is 160 CNY for one month and less. Please buy the insurance after May 12 but before May 20 prior to your entry, and send your receipt to your university who should then send to SDUST no later than May 25. Those without buying the insurance shall not be offered the Admission Notice and other visa application documents.
